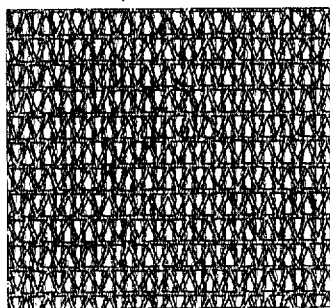

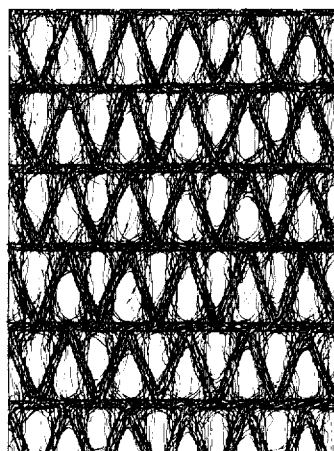


FIG. 1 is a plan view of an apertured nonwoven fabric showing our new design; and
