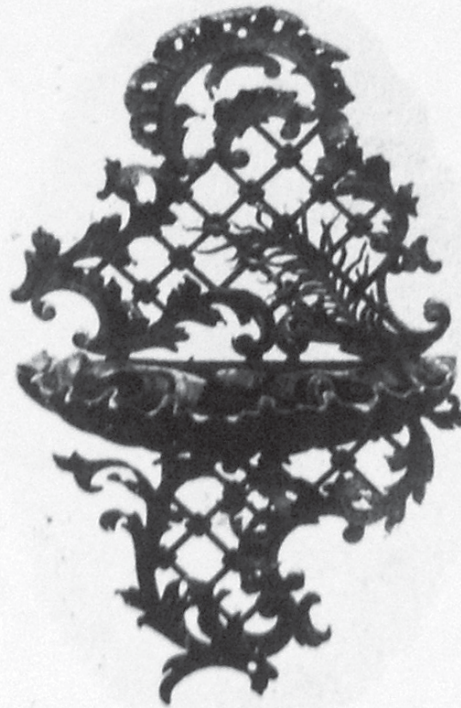

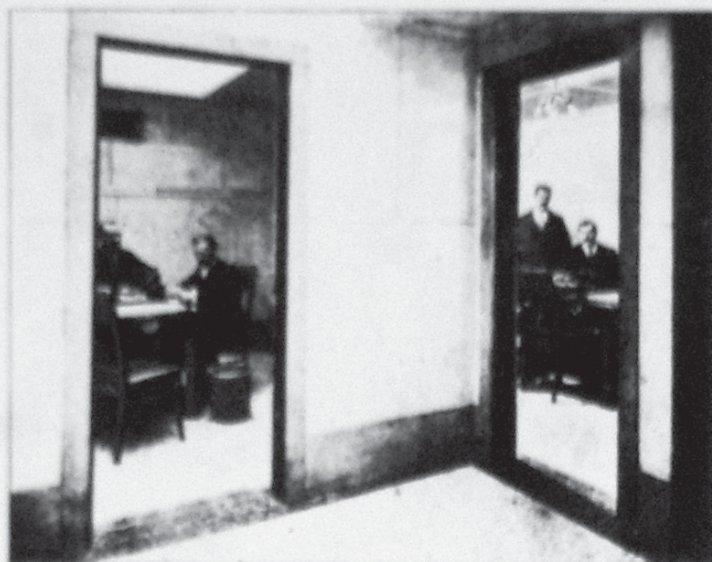
A Decorative Cover by Mr. Frank Leyendecker and a Frontispiece by Miss Blanche Ostertag will be features of the Christmas number.

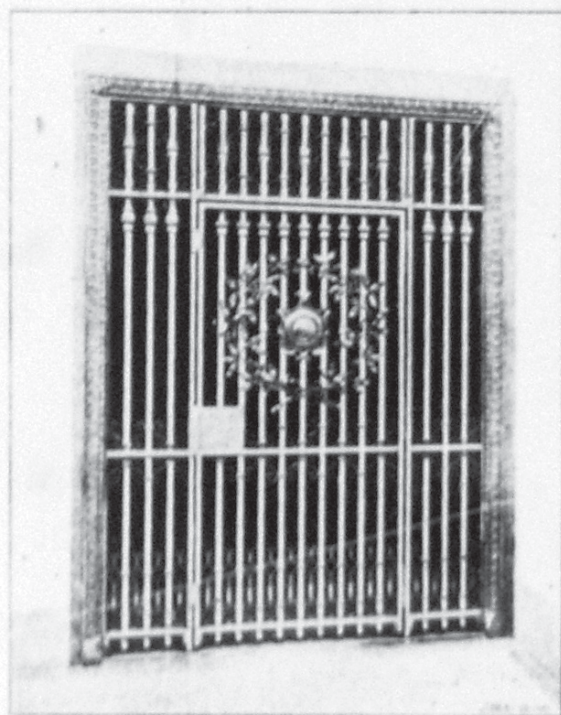
